Consideration and action on SECOND and FINAL READING of Ordinance Number 2001-1368 authorizing the issuance of City of Brownsville, Texas Utilities System Subordinate Lien Revenue and Refunding Bonds, Series 2001A and 2001B; providing for the payment of the principal of and the interest on the bonds by a subordinate lien on and pledge on the pledged revenues of the City's Utilities Systems and the purchase of bond insurance; providing the terms and conditions of such bonds and resolving other matters incident and relating to the issuance, payment, security, sale, and delivery of such bonds, including the approval and distribution of an official statement pertaining thereto; authorizing the execution of a paying agent/registrar agreement, remarketing agreements, a stand-by bond purchasing agreement, and insurance reimbursement and indemnity agreement, and an escrow agreement, complying with the requirements of the depository trust company; enacting other provisions incident to and related to the subject and purpose of this Ordinance; and providing for an effective date.
