Pursuant to Chapter 551, Title 5 of the Texas Government Code, the Texas Open Meetings Act, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that I, Blanca S. Vela, Mayor of the City of Brownsville, Texas, in accordance with Article V, Section 12, of the Charter of said City, do hereby call a SPECIAL MEETING of the City Commission of the City of Brownsville, to convene on **Wednesday, October 17, 2001, at 6:00 pm**, in the City Commission Chambers on the second floor of City Hall/Market Square, Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas, 78520. At said special meeting, the following items will be considered:

1. Consideration and action on SECOND AND FINAL READING of the following Ordinance(s) annexing certain territory to the City of Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas, and extending the boundary limits of said City so as to include such property within said City limits, and granting to all the inhabitants of such property all the rights and privileges of other citizens and binding said inhabitants by all of the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said City:
 - a. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.45 (in Espiritu Santo Grant [ESG] and San Pedro de Carricitos Grant near Expressway 77/83);
 - b. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.46 (in Share 14 of ESG west of FM 803);
 - c. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.47 (in and near National Wildlife Refuge west of FM 1421);
 - d. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.48 (near said Refuge);
 - e. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.49 (in and near said Refuge);
 - f. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.50 (in and near National Wildlife Refuge south of SH 100);
 - g. Ordinance Number 2001-1200.51 (in ESG and Santa Isabel Grant near SH 100);

2. Public hearing and action on FIRST READING of Ordinance Number 2001-1200.52, consenting to the creation of a new city to be called La Encantada, and dealing with related matters.
3. Public hearing and action on FIRST READING of Ordinance Number 2001-1200.53, requesting the County Commissioners Court to select five representatives of La Encantada area to negotiate an agreement in lieu of annexation, and dealing with related matters.
