Consideration and action on SECOND AND FINAL READING of Ordinance Number 2001-983-X, repealing or amending Ordinance Number 1999-983-T, which amends Chapter 34 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Utilities" and which provides for electric service rates and charges and conditions of services, by amending Section 34-84 relating to the authority of the Public Utilities Board to contract with certain electric customers, providing a severability clause and an effective date.
  
2. Consideration and action on SECOND AND FINAL READING of Ordinance Number 2001-1381, authorizing interest rate hedge and insurance agreements; providing for payments by a subordinate lien on and pledge of the pledged revenues of the City's utilities systems; providing for a effective date; and dealing with related matters.
