ADDENDA: The undersigned hereby acknowledges receipt of the following addenda to the Specifications, all of the provisions and requirements of which Addenda have been taken into consideration in the preparation of the foregoing proposal.

1.- Changes have been made to the Specifications:

Business Requirements

Certificate of Occupancy

Use and Occupancy. No building or structure shall be used or occupied, and no change in the existing occupancy classification of a building or structure or portion thereof shall be made until the building official has issued a certificate of occupancy therefor as provided herein. Issuance of a certificate of occupancy shall not be construed as an approval of a violation of the provisions of this code or of other ordinances of the jurisdiction.

Certificate Issued

After the building official inspects the building or structure and finds no violations of the provisions of this code or other laws that are enforced by the department of building safety, the building official shall issue a certificate of occupancy that contains the following:

1. The Building Permit Number
2. The address of the structure.
3. The name and address of the owner
4. A description of that portion of the structure has been for which the certificate is issued.
5. A statement that the described portion of the structure has been inspected for compliance with the requirements of the code for the occupancy and division of occupancy and the use for which the proposal occupancy is classified.
6. The name of the building official
7. The edition of the code under which the permit was issued.
8. The use and occupancy, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3.
9. The type of construction as defined in chapter 6
10. The design occupant load.
11. If an automatic sprinkler system is provided, whether the sprinkler system is required.
12. Any special stipulations and conditions of the building permit.

Temporary Occupancy

The building official is authorized to issue a temporary certificate of occupancy before the completion of the entire work covered by the permit, provided that such portion or portions shall be occupied safely. The building official shall set a time period during which the temporary certificate of occupancy is valid.

Revocation

The building official is authorized to, in writing, suspend or revoke a certificate of occupancy or completion issued under the provisions of this code wherever the certificate is issued in error, or on the basis of incorrect information supplied, or where it is determined that the building or structure or portion thereof is in violation of any ordinance or regulation or any provisions of this code.

Change in Bid Submittal Deadline

The bid submittal deadline is hereby changed to Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at 3:00 p.m., Central Standard Time. Location of submittal remains unchanged.

Changes in Contract Manual

1. Substitute the enclosed revised Bid Schedule sheets BP-1 through BP-13, for those of the original issue.
2. Time for Completion is hereby changed throughout the manual to 150 "Working Days." Working Days shall be as defined in Texas Department of Transportation 1993 Standard Specifications. (*Copy of definition is included in the addendum as Attachment "A".*)

Clarifications

1. All existing roadway surface, base and subgrade material removed from this project shall become the property of the contractor to be properly disposed of at his expense.
2. Alley removal inadvertently shown on Plan Sheet No. 3A at approximate Station 5+50 is not part of this project.
3. Detail No. 7 on Sheet No. 11 is hereby revised to require #4 bar reinforcing at 12" O.C. Bothways.
4. A bid item has been added for repair of Soft Spots in Existing Subgrade. This item will be used only where deemed necessary by the City Inspector or Project Engineer.

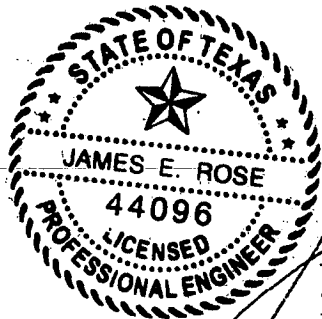
It is the City's intent for the existing roadway materials and necessary subgrade excavation to be removed one block at a time, subgrade to be quickly checked for soft spots and repaired, if deemed necessary by the City Inspector or Project Engineer, and new base material installed as soon as possible to minimize time of exposure of existing subgrade to the elements.

The contractor will not be paid for correction of soft spots caused by avoidable prolonged exposure of the subgrade.

- 5. Backfill of all trenches including pipe removal trenches and new pipe installation trenches shall be done with riversand and in accordance with the standard BPUB detail.
- 6. The 24 inch force main segment shown on Sheet 5B at Jackson Street must be installed below existing waterlines with top of pipe at a depth of approximately 7 feet below existing pavement surface.
- 7. Engineer's Estimate for this project is as shown below:

1.64. Superstructure. That part of the structure above the bridge seats or above the springing lines of arches.

1.65. Supplemental Agreements. Written agreements entered into between the Contractor and the State and approved by the Surety, covering alterations and changes in the contract.

1.66. Surety. The corporate body or bodies authorized to do business in Texas bound with and for the Contractor for the faithful performance of the work covered by the contract and for the payment for all labor and material supplied in the prosecution of the work.

1.67. Temporary Structures. All temporary bridges, culverts and structures required to maintain traffic during the construction of work.

1.68. TMUTCD. Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

1.69. Traffic Lane. The strip of roadway intended to accommodate the forward movement of a single line of vehicles.

1.70. Traveled Way. The portion of the roadway for the movement of vehicles, exclusive of shoulders and auxiliary lanes.

1.71. The Work. The work shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and other incidentals necessary or convenient to the successful completion of the project and the carrying out of all the duties and obligations imposed by the contract.

1.72. Working Day. A working day is defined as a calendar day, not including Saturdays, Sundays, or legal holidays authorized in the list prepared by the Department for contract purposes, in which weather or other conditions not under the control of the Contractor will permit the performance of the principal unit of work underway for a continuous period of not less than 7 hours between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. For every Saturday or legal holiday except the following holidays:

January 1st, the last Monday in May, July 4th, the first Monday in September, the fourth Thursday in November and December 25th

on which the Contractor chooses to work, one day will be charged against the contract working time when weather conditions will permit 7 hours of

work as delineated above. The principal unit of work shall be that unit which controls the completion time of the contract. Nothing in this Item shall be construed as prohibiting the Contractor from working on Saturdays or legal holidays, except the six listed above, if he so desires. Work on Sunday and on the six legal holidays listed above will not be permitted except in cases of extreme emergency or when the safety of the Contractor's forces and/or the traveling public would be significantly improved, and then only with the written permission of the Engineer. If Sunday work or work on the six legal holidays listed above is permitted, working time will be charged on the same basis as week days.

The Engineer may suspend the work and the "Time Charge", in accordance with Article 8.4, on any holiday, on the day preceding the holiday or on the day following the holiday if the Engineer and the Contractor mutually agree the Contractor should not work. Such suspension shall be based upon (a) past experience as to the volume of holiday traffic that may be expected and (b) the hazard to the traveling public and/or Contractor's employees that project operations would present.

1.73. Work Order. Written notice to the Contractor to begin with the contract work; when applicable, includes the date of beginning of contract.

ITEM 2

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

2.1. Contents of Proposal Forms. Upon written request, bidders will be furnished with a proposal form which will state the location and description of the proposed work, an approximate estimate of the various quantities and kinds of work to be performed or materials to be furnished, a schedule of items for which unit prices are requested and the time within which the work is to be completed. The special provisions and special specifications will be bound in the proposal form.

2.2. Interpretation of Estimates of Quantities. The quantities listed in the proposal form will be considered as approximate and will be used for the comparison of bids. However, payments to the Contractor will be made for the work done in accordance with Item 4, "Scope of Work", and Item 9, "Measurement and Payment".
